

Privacy Policy

Deletion / blocking of personal data

An important principle of the basic EU data protection regulation is data avoidance and data economy. Our company adheres to these principles and we only store personal data for as long as is necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or in accordance with the legal retention periods. After the loss of a corresponding basis (contract, consent, legal regulation,...) we routinely delete or block this data.

Collection of data when you visit our website

When you visit our website, data is automatically collected from our server and the following data is stored in the log files of our system:

- Browser type and versioning
- Requester's operating system used
- IP address
- date and time of the website request
- domain names of the provider

A direct assignment of the personal data to a specific user will not take place, so that an identification to individual page visitors will not take place.

We collect this data on the basis of our legitimate interest in order to further optimize the technology, to ensure the establishment of the connection to our website, to ensure the availability of our web services and for further administrative purposes.

If necessary, anonymized information is evaluated for statistical purposes, which, however, does not allow any conclusions to be drawn about specific or identifiable persons.

Cookies

So-called "cookies" are also used on our website. Cookies are small text files that are transferred from our system to your hard drive. These cookies automatically provide us with certain information. These could include your IP address, the browser you use to access our website, your operating system and other data.

Cookies are usually used to facilitate the use of the website for the user and to enable a perfect display of our services. Cookies cannot start programs or even transmit viruses to your system.

Under no circumstances will the data we collect be passed on to third parties or linked to personal data without your consent.

Most browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. However, you can deactivate the storage of cookies or set your browser so that it informs you as soon as cookies are sent. Once cookies have been set, you can delete them yourself at any time by calling up the corresponding menu item in your Internet browser or deleting the cookies on your hard disk. Details can be found in the help menu of your Internet browser.

If you contact us by email and you send us this email unencrypted, we cannot guarantee the data security of the transmission path to us. If you wish to send us data requiring protection, we ask you to send it to us in encrypted form or by post.
